#### **Important Deadlines & Submission Guidelines**

- 1. The deadline for submitting a detailed abstract (300 words) and full author details is September 31, 2024. Selection of papers is based on the abstract, and presenters will be notified by the end of October 2024.
- 2. The full paper is due on February 28, 2025.
- 3. Both abstracts and full papers should be submitted as an MS Word file by e-mail.
- 4. Papers should be no more than 5,000 words, single-spaced, in Times New Roman, 12-point font.
- 5. Papers should be in English.
- 6. Papers should be the original work of the authors.
- 7. Posters should be prepared and forwarded by March 2025.
